

100 Billion Neurons

Smell

Eight hours of sleep per day is 122 days per year. People blink about 12 times per minute.

EMOT

Taste

Nerve signals can travel up to 268 miles per hour.

CONT

About 8% of males and 0.5% of females are colorblind.

ROLS

The human brain has 100 trillion synaptic connections.

A jellyfish has no brain.

Vision

A giraffe sleeps only 2 hours a day.

An elephant brain weighs about 6.0 kg.

Hearing

The human eyeball is 24.5 mm long.

Brain Origami


1. Cut along the dashed line to remove the pattern.
2. Turn the paper over so that the printed side is down.
3. Bend the four corners to the center of the paper.



4. Turn the paper over.
5. Bring the four corners to the center of the paper.



6. Fold the paper in half.



7. Put your thumb and first fingers in the outside pockets.
8. Bring the corners together.
9. Open and close origami to reveal brain facts.
