

Inpatient Facility

MARQUAM HILL

The Marquam Hill Campus is OHSU's largest. It is located south and west of downtown Portland. OHSU's administrative offices are located on Marquam Hill Campus, as well as OHSU Hospital, Doernbecher Children's Hospital, several patient care pavilions housing numerous medical practices; the Schools of Medicine, Dentistry and Nursing,; and multiple research centers and labs.

Note: Due to the construction of the Portland Aerial Tram, S.W. Campus Drive is closed to personal vehicles beyond the entrance to Kohler Pavilion. S.W. Campus Drive will reopen to through traffic after the Tram has opened.

MARQUAM HILL BY PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION

TriMet bus 8, which runs about every 20 minutes from the downtown Portland transit mall, provides direct service to OHSU. During rush hour only, additional TriMet buses serve OHSU, including 61X, 65X and 68.

Portland Tram

The Portland Aerial Tram will be open to the public in early 2007. The Tram connects Portland's new South Waterfront neighborhood and the OHSU Center for Health & Healing with Marquam Hill. The upper terminus connects to the Kohler Pavilion and provides easy access to all buildings and services on Marquam Hill. The lower terminus is next to the OHSU Center for Health & Healing, which houses multiple doctor's offices, March Wellness Center, and an Optical Shop, retail pharmacy and deli.

DRIVING TO MARQUAM HILL

From Lake Oswego/Sellwood Bridge area

- Travel north on S.W. Macadam Avenue.
- Turn left onto S.W. Boundary Street.
- Proceed one block and turn right onto S.W. Corbett Avenue
- Turn left onto S.W. Hamilton Street.
- Turn right onto S.W. Barbur Boulevard and continue for approximately 2.5 miles.
- At the second light past the YMCA (on the left), make a sharp left turn onto S.W. Caruthers Street.
- Turn left at the second light onto S.W. 6th Avenue.
- Follow the directions listed below to the clinic, hospital or building you are visiting.

From the West

- Travel east on Hwy. 26/Sunset Hwy.
- Stay in the right lane and follow the signs to I-405 (Salem/The Dalles).
- After passing through the Vista Ridge tunnel, stay to the right as the freeway branches.
- Take the S.W. 6th Avenue exit.
- Turn right onto S.W. 6th Avenue.
- Follow the directions listed below to the clinic, hospital or building you are visiting.

From the East

- Travel west on I-84 to the juncture with I-5.
 - Follow I-5 south toward Salem.
 - As you cross the Marquam Bridge, merge into one of the two left lanes, following the signs to City Center/Beaverton.
 - Take the S.W. 6th Avenue exit.
 - Immediately move to the left lane and turn onto S.W. College Street (or the next possible street that allows a left turn.)
 - Turn left onto S.W. Broadway Avenue and move to the right lane.
 - Bear right onto S.W. 6th Avenue, following signs to OHSU.
 - Follow the directions listed below to the clinic, hospital or building you are visiting.
-

From the South via I-5

- Travel north on I-5.
- Take exit 297 (Terwilliger Boulevard).
- Turn left at stop light onto S.W. Terwilliger Boulevard.
- Turn right onto S.W. Barbur Boulevard and continue for approximately 2.5 miles.
- At the second light past the YMCA, make a sharp left turn onto S.W. Caruthers Street.
- Turn left onto S.W. 6th Avenue.
- Follow the directions listed below to the clinic, hospital or building you are visiting.

From the South using S.W. Barbur Blvd.

- Travel north on S.W. Barbur Blvd.
 - At the second light past the YMCA (on the left), make a sharp left turn onto S.W. Caruthers Street.
 - At the second light, turn left onto S.W. 6th Avenue.
 - Follow the directions listed below to the clinic, hospital or building you are visiting.

From the Southeast

- Travel north on S.E. McLoughlin Boulevard or west on S.E. Powell Boulevard.
 - After crossing the Ross Island Bridge, take the City Center exit.
 - Follow S.W. Corbett Avenue, staying in the left lane.
 - S.W. Corbett will turn into S.W. Kelly, then into S.W. Arthur, and finally into S.W. Caruthers before ending at S.W. 6th Avenue.
 - Turn left onto S.W. 6th Avenue.
 - Follow the directions listed below to the clinic, hospital or building you are visiting.
-

From the North

- Travel south on I-5 toward Salem.
- As you cross the Marquam Bridge, merge into one of the two left lanes, following signs to City

Center/Beaverton.

- Take the S.W. 6th Avenue exit
 - Immediately move to the left lane and turn onto S.W. College Street (or the next possible street that allows a left turn.)
 - Turn left onto S.W. Broadway and move to the right lane.
 - Bear right onto S.W. 6th Avenue, following the signs to OHSU.
 - Follow the directions listed below to the clinic, hospital or building you are visiting.
-

From the Northwest

- Travel southeast on Hwy. 30 (St. Helens Road) toward City Center, following signs to I-405.
- Take I-405 south.
- Take the S.W. 6th Avenue exit.
- Turn right on S.W. 6th Avenue, following the signs to OHSU.
- Follow the directions listed below to the clinic, hospital or building you are visiting.

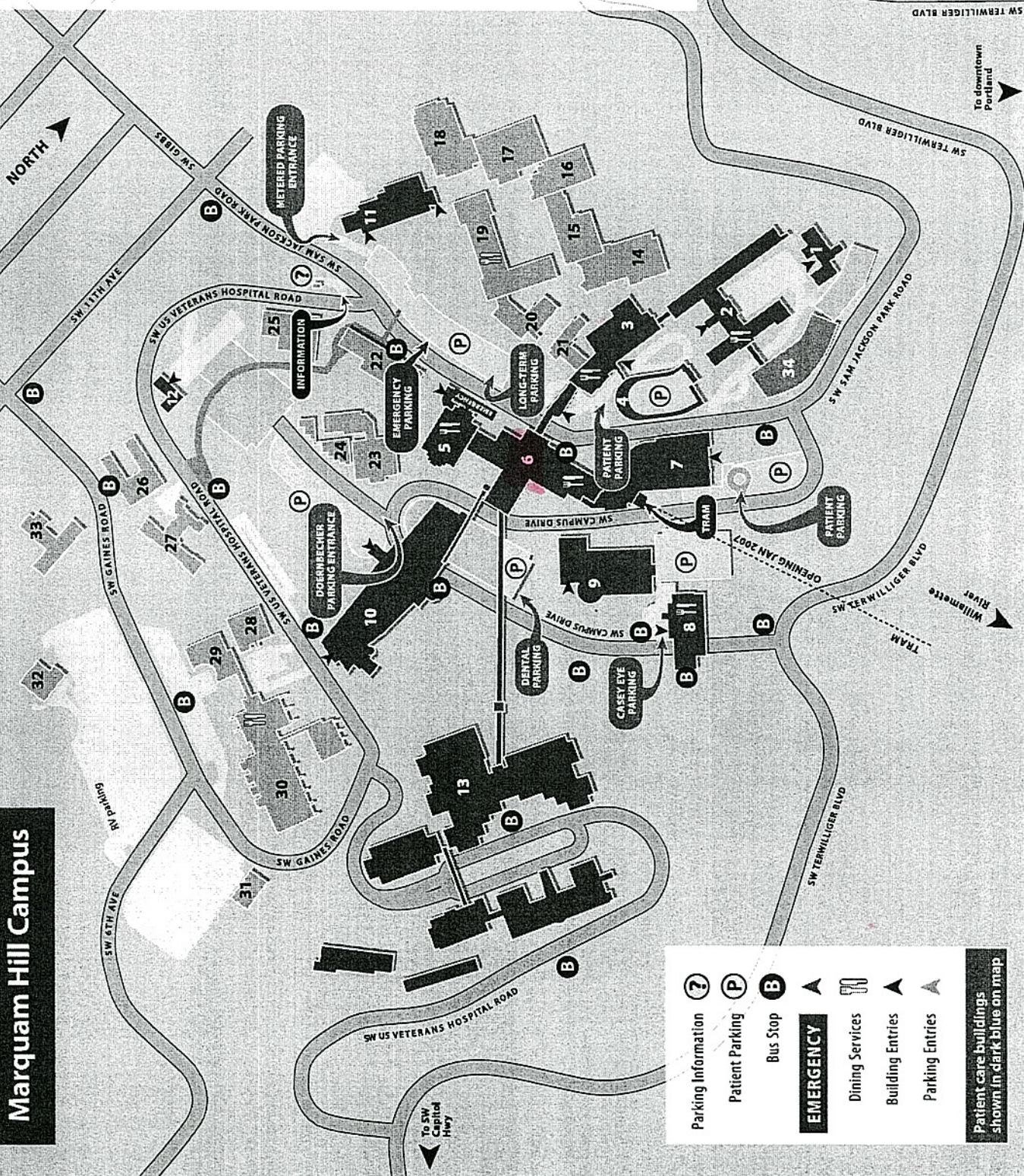

Driving directions to the OHSU Center for Health & Healing

From downtown Portland

- Proceed south, then turn left onto S.W. Harrison Street.
- Cross over Naito Parkway.
- Turn right onto S.W. Moody.
- Turn left onto S.W. Curry.
- Turn left onto S.W. Bond.
- Turn left onto S.W. Whitaker to enter the parking garage.

From the north via I-5 or the east via I-84

(Note: If you are traveling west on I-84, merge onto I-5 South, then follow these directions.)

- Stay in the right lane as you cross the river on the Marquam Bridge.
- Take exit 299A to 43/Lake Oswego/Macadam. As you exit, move to the middle lane.
- Follow the signs to "South Waterfront." As the road curves to the left, stay to the left.
- At the light, turn left onto S.W. Macadam.
- Turn right onto S.W. Curry.
- Turn left onto S.W. Bond.
- Turn left onto S.W. Whitaker to enter the parking garage.

From the north via I-405

- Follow signs for I-405 (Salem/The Dalles.)
- Take Exit 1C (S.W. 6th Ave.)
- Stay in left lane and follow signs for 6th Ave/City Center/Auditorium.
- Turn left onto S.W. 6th Ave.
- Turn right onto S.W. Harrison.
- Cross over S.W. Naito Parkway.
- Turn right onto S.W. Moody Ave.
- Turn left onto S.W. Curry.
- Turn left onto S.W. Bond.
- Turn left onto S.W. Whitaker to enter the parking garage.

From the south via S.W. Macadam or Sellwood Bridge

- Travel north on S.W. Macadam.
- Turn right onto S.W. Curry.
- Turn left onto S.W. Bond.
- Turn left onto S.W. Whitaker to enter the parking garage.

Public Transportation (TriMet and Portland Streetcar)

The Portland Streetcar has been extended to service Portland's South Waterfront. The streetcar stops at the corner of S.W. Moody and S.W. Gibbs, which is across the street and just north of the Center for Health & Healing. Patients and visitors may ride a TriMet bus downtown and transfer to the Portland Streetcar. The closest streetcar stop to the downtown transit mall is at S.W. 5th and Market. The streetcar accommodates bikes and wheelchairs. Parking

The OHSU Center for Health & Healing offers its patients free parking in the center's parking garage. The entrance to the garage is on S.W. Whitaker, directly across the street from the center.

During construction at South Waterfront, please watch for detour signs and flaggers directing traffic.

From the south via S.W. Barbur Blvd.

- Travel north on S.W. Barbur Blvd.
- Exit onto S.W. Naito Parkway.
- Turn right onto S.W. Harrison.
- Turn right onto S.W. Moody.
- Turn left onto S.W. Curry.
- Turn left onto S.W. Bond.
- Turn left onto S.W. Whitaker to enter the parking garage.

From the south via I-5

- Take exit 299A (43/26 East Ross Island Bridge/Macadam.)
- At first stop light, turn right onto S.W. Curry.
- Turn left onto S.W. Bond.
- Turn left onto S.W. Whitaker to enter the parking garage.

From the east via the Ross Island Bridge

- After crossing the river on the Ross Island Bridge, take the exit on the right to 43/Lake Oswego/Macadam.
- Follow the signs to "South Waterfront." As the road curves to the left, stay to the left.
- At the light, turn left onto S.W. Macadam.
- Turn right onto S.W. Curry.
- Turn left onto S.W. Bond.
- Turn left onto S.W. Whitaker to enter the parking garage.

From the west via Hwy 26

- Pass through the Vista Tunnel and stay in the center lane to exit onto S.W. Market Street.
- Stay on Market Street.
- Cross over Naito Parkway onto S.W. Harbor Drive.
- At the second light, turn left onto S.W. Harrison.
- Turn right onto S.W. Moody.
- Turn left onto S.W. Curry.
- Turn left onto S.W. Bond.
- Turn left onto S.W. Whitaker to enter the parking garage.

Portland Aerial Tram

The Portland Aerial Tram is a convenient method of alternative transportation when traveling between South Waterfront and Marquam Hill. Patients who have appointments and want to use the Tram as transportation between these two locations may pick up a free fare ticket at the Center's Welcome Desk or from their doctor's office in the Center on the day of their appointment. Although patients traveling from Marquam Hill for an appointment in the Center for Health & Healing do not need a ticket, they must pick up a ticket at the Welcome Desk for their Tram ride back to Marquam Hill. Tram hours are: Monday-Friday, 6 a.m. to 10 p.m., and Saturday, 9 a.m. to 5 p.m. Additional information is available on the Web at www.portlandtram.org.

TriMet will not begin bus routes to South Waterfront until fall 2007.

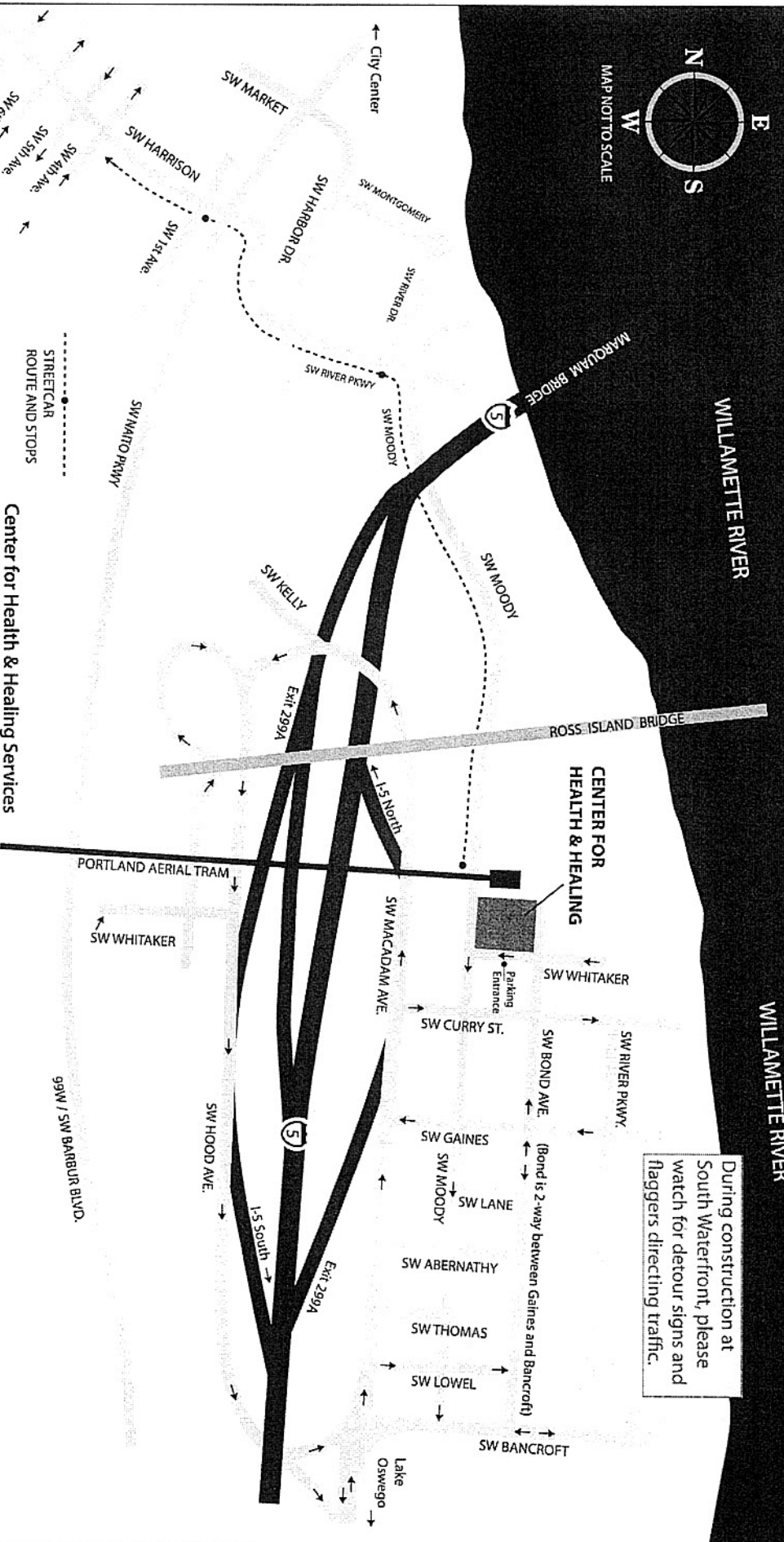


MAP NOT TO SCALE
