

## X-Win32<sup>1</sup>

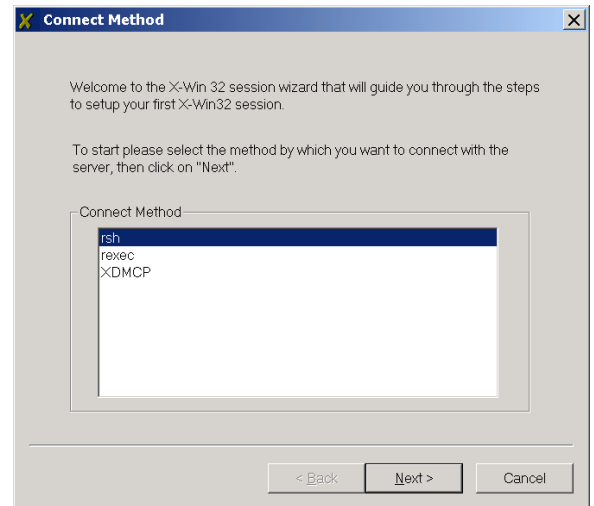
X-Win32 allows you to run graphical programs. The UW has a site license, so it can be installed on UW machines at added cost.

Find X-Win32 and bring it up.

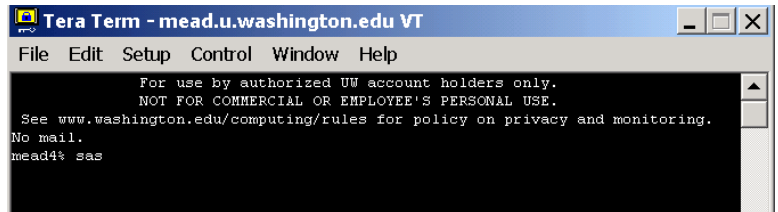


The dialogue box to the right will appear. Click on Cancel.

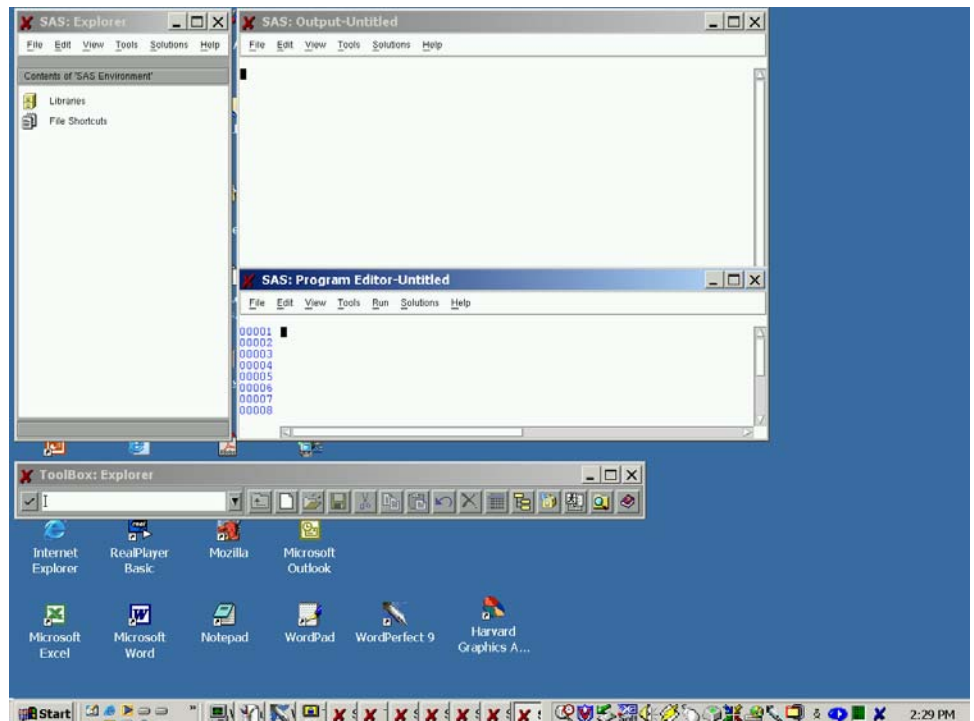
An X will appear at the bottom right of your screen.



Access Tera Term, and login to goodal.u.washington.edu if you are a student, and mead.u.washington.edu if you are staff or faculty.
