WMRRA'S VOLUNTEERS: A Closer Look

THANKS FOR ALL THE HARD WORK YOU DO FOR WMRRA!

Jeff Wiend (aka Penguin and WMRRA #460) raced in the early 90's with WMRRA and OMRRA on a Suzuki VX800 tuned by his friend Mark Appleby. Russ (aka The Coneman) assisted in the pits and with driving the team "hauler" (Mom's fifth wheel and pick-up) to and from the races.

Jeff returned to racing in 2003 on a Buell XB9R and Russ immediately came to his rescue and became "the best one-man pit crew in the world." The whole situation changed when Jeff offered his and Russ' help when there weren't enough corner workers to allow racing. After the races Russ informed Jeff that after the next race, he was on his own as Russ was going to corner work from then on. Ask Russ why...Don't ask Jeff!

At the end of the 2003 season Jeff was awarded one of the volunteers of the year. He then decided that his only shot at getting awards was to volunteer sooo...good-bye racing, hello corner workers!

Russ can be found in turn #9 at Pacific and is our "crossing guard" in Spokane. He can be seen along with his red Ford Lightning, lights flashing filled with corner workers cruising around a track near you. And who knows he just might be doing backwards the whole way. (His version of "backin' it in".)

Jeff can be found in the "Bus-stop" at Pacific and turn #4 in Spokane. He can be seen dragging 'boards and breaking belts on his Harley 'bagger at a track near you. He helps with the Pushrod racing Team when he can (Go Brad #428!!!) and is the contingency co-coordinator for the club. He also gets off on being the "Taste of Racing" manager which cures his need to race, although he still races the occasional endurance race.

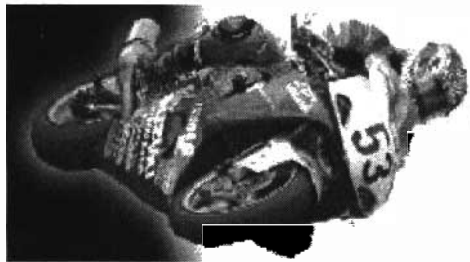
Jeff and Russ were the co-recipients of the corner worker of the year award for 2004. They can be called upon to do whatever it takes to get the races going and keep them going. Just don't mess with Russ' cones in Spokane and stay to the RIGHT.

In July, they were selected to corner work for the MotoGP races and "would like to thank Nadia and the entire race day staff for the knowledge and patience that you all exhibited in training us over the years that helped us become FIM flaggers." They worked the exit of turn #4 and were lucky enough to be seen by millions of viewers around the world on almost every lap. If you venture down to Laguna next year...stop by and say "hi".

They enjoy the friends and friendships they've made at WMRRA and look forward to many more years of service to the club and its racers. They love the racing action and the close proximity to racing that corner working affords them. If you want to come out and see what corner working is all about, talk with Jeff or Russ...but be forewarned, it can be very addicting.
