Sarah Maria Dorcy and David Oliver Spangler

Sarah Maria Dorcy was born in Big Rapids, Michigan on 23 April 1889. Shortly after she was born her family took up a homestead near McHenry, Mississippi. The first thing we hear about her is in a letter written by her mother, Bridget to her grandmother, Mary Ellen, back in Michigan. Bridget says,

"sarah larns her book one hour a day she is busie paren [peeling] shugar cane and chewing it".

The letter is dated 18 Nov. 1894 so Sarah was just over 5 years old.

The next news we have is again in a letter from her mother to the family in Ireland. She talks of Sarah again and says she is 16 and larger than her mother. Sarah was working as a domestic in Folsom, Louisiana (15 miles from New Orleans) and had been for 13 months. Her mother, Bridget was very lonely for her.

In 1909 she met David Spangler at the Seattle World's Fair. He was born in Missouri in 1884 the son of Daniel Webster Spangler and Mary Alice Packwood. Sarah and David were married in November in Vancouver, British Columbia by H. Francis Perry, D.D. They may have lived in British Columbia for some time since their first child, Louise, was born there. By 1914 they are living in Bellingham in the Fairhaven area, at first on 10th Street. In 1919 they bought "The Ranch" on Cody Street, so called by the grandchildren. It was a wonderful rickety old house with a picket fence. Sarah was an excellent cook and worked in restaurants and bakeries most of her life. David worked as a laborer, dock worker, a planerman and later as a machinist in the mills around Bellingham. Sarah's nieces remember her wearing hats! It seemed she never went anywhere without wearing some interesting hat. Sarah and Dave moved to Bagley Avenue in Seattle sometime after 1941 and they lived there for many years. A man named Max Stave, a merchant seaman and cousin of Louise's husband, Perry Love, was a

long time family friend. He often stayed in their home when he was in port. David died in 1956 in Seattle eighteen years before Sarah, who died in 1974 in Seattle.

The children are:

- (4) Louise Muriel Spangler was born in 1910 in Vancouver, BC. She married Perry Otho Love in Bellingham, Washington in 1929. Perry was a sheet metal worker and they moved to Seattle in September 1939. Louise died of a cerebral hemorrhage in Seattle in 1950. They had four little girls:
 - (5) Vivian Louise Love was born in 1931 in Bellingham. After graduating from high school in Seattle she bought a restaurant to help care for her younger sisters. Because she was interested in art, the former owner of her restaurant introduced her to John, also an art lover. She married John Boyd Weers in 1953 in Seattle. John was born in Illinois in 1925, a member of a most illustrious family. His grandfather founded the town of Danville, Illinois. An uncle founded a power company, an aunt was a first woman mortician and there are other prominent people among his ancestors. John joined the Navy at age 17 serving in three invasions, Leyte, Borneo, and Luzon, as well as the Surigo Straights. At the war's end in 1945 he returned to Illinois and Bradley University earning a Bachelor of Fine Arts degree. John was working as the staff artist for Kenworth Company in Seattle when Vivian met him, but spent most of his working years as an engineer for Boeing Company. Thev continued their studying when they could and John still teaches art history and is a docent for elementary children. Vivian says she has two main interests in her life, art and kids; so it was natural for them to step in when they found the need to care for their own grandchildren. They legally adopted them and soon realized there were no support groups for this difficult task. They became founders of the official organization for Washington State known as "United Grandparents Raising Grandchildren". This is the first and so far the only non-profit Washington corporation in for grandparents raising grandchildren. They spend many hours writing for grants and staffing an office to disseminate information so support groups can be formed where they are needed. Their children are:
 - (6) Vicki Lynne Weers was born in Everett in 1954. She earned her Associates degree from North Seattle Community college and attended the University of Washington for one year before joining the Air force where she served for two years. Vicky married James Edward Davis and their children are:

- (6) John Curtis Weers was born in 1957 in Seattle. He is called Curt. He attended North Seattle community College and graduated from Renton Vocational/Technical School. He works in the corporate headquarters for Boeing Company and is their expert on Military Standards. Curt has rewritten and updated the manual for military affairs for the Boeing Company. Curt is not married.
- (5) Joyce Nelene Love (called Joy) was born in Bellingham, Washington in 1933. She graduated from high school in Bellingham and married Bernard Charles Koslosky, Sr., in Seattle in 1951. He was born in Scranton, Pennsylvania in 1929 the son of Bernard Kazlauskas (the name is Lithuanian) and Julia Kadjeski. Joyce worked for the Federal Reserve Bank from 1951 till 1955 and again from 1965 until 1989. She has owned and managed a triplex since 1986. Joyce's special interests are kids, and grandchildren, sewing, handwork and working in the yard. Bernie served two years in the US Army and in 1951 went to work for Cudahy-Bar-S Meat Packing Company. Since 1986 he has been with Broadmoor Golf Club. Joy and Bernie's children are:
 - (6) Julia Louise Koslosky was born in Seattle in 1953. She earned a B.S. Degree in Clinical Chemistry from Seattle University. She is currently a homemaker and volunteers at the schools as well as gardening, sewing, doing crafts. Julia married Roy Oliver Briggs, Jr., in 1974 in Seattle. Roy was born in Hampton, Virginia in 1951 and is the son of Roy Oliver and Melvin (Firman) Briggs. He studied music at Shoreline Community College and has worked for the Seattle Times since 1969 and is now district advisor. She is employed by the grocery outlet in Everett and enjoys crafts, especially miniatures and doll house building.
- (7) Caryn Jean Briggs was born in 1980 in Seattle. She plays soccer, is on the Snohomish High School news paper staff and is considering a career in journalism or meteorology.
- (7) Roy Oliver Briggs, 3rd was born in 1982 in Seattle. He will start Snohomish High and JROTC in the fall of 1996. He likes genealogy, designing board games, computers and medieval history.
- (7) Robert Charles Briggs was born in 1989 in Seattle. He loves school, soccer and making things from any media.
- (6) Bernard Charles Koslosky Jr., (called Chuck), was born in 1955 in Seattle. He is a licensed Steam Engineer and the Senior Plant Engineer for Northwest Hospital. Chuck is a soccer coach, baseball umpire, bass guitar player and loves the outdoors. He married Teresa Lynn Brooks in 1985 in Woodenville, Washington and adopted her daughter Marguarite in 1988. Marguarite Brooks was born in Seattle in 1983 and plays clarinet and flute as well as soccer and loves Dalmations. Teresa is the daughter of James and Barbara Joan "Jolly" Brooks.  - (6) William Allen Cummins was born in Seattle in 1960. Al married Mary Jo McCarty in 1984 in Seattle, Washington. Mary Jo was born in 1959 and their child is:
 - (7) Jonathan Earl Cummins was born in Seattle in 1987.
- (4) David Leonard Spangler was born in Bellingham in 1914. and graduated from Fairhaven High School He was called Dave and his son was David to tell them apart. He is the nephew who saved the piano from the burning house of Wm. T. Dorcy when he was about 15 years old. In 1936 he is listed in the city directory as a mill worker at Bloedel Donovan Mill in Bellingham. He moved to Seattle after his son was born. Dave was a master machinist and taught apprentices. He enjoyed dressing specially for different occasions and almost always wore a completely white outfit including a white cap to the "Dorcy Gatherings". Some of the family thought he was a baker by trade and

some called him the "Ice cream man" because of this white outfit. Dave married Nora Lucile Mariotto in 1937 in Bellingham. Nora was born in 1916 in Raton, NM, the daughter of Ed and Caterina Mariotto. She retired from Boeing after thirty five years of service. Their child is:

- (5) David Cyrus Spangler was born in Bellingham in 1938. He served in the U.S. Army Corp of Engineers and was assigned the job of surveying the desert near Death Valley. He married first Virginia Huffman in 1962 whom he met in California while serving in the army. They divorced in 1964. Their child is:
 - (6) David Jason Spangler was born about 1963 in Pamona, CA He is living in California.

After discharge from the army David went to work in Aero Space Engineering, first for Boeing in Seattle then for Douglas in Santa Monica. He was transfered to Huntsville, AL to work on the "Man on The Moon project" (the Saturn Rocket) and he worked for Douglas through the "Sky-Lab project" While with the "Sky-Lab project" he worked and trained with the astronauts. He earned a BSBA from the University of Alabama in 1974 and an MBA in 1976. He has lived for thirty years in Huntsville and currently owns a video production business. He married Mary Margaret Neeley in 1968 and was divorced from her in 1975. David is planning to return to live in Washington in 1997 so he can again be close to family. David enjoys bridge, chess, and golf. In June, 1996 David went to Mississippi to find the homestead where his grandmother spent her childhood. He brought back some earth from the homestead and he calls it "The Dorcy Dirt". David and Mary Margaret's child is:
