Portraits of Mariampolers

The Mariampoler Aid Society (M.A.S.) in Chicago published yearbooks from 1945 to 1950. These yearbooks contained selected stories from the Mariampoler Aid Society bulletins and advertisements. The advertisements were solicited from members in order to raise money for the charitable activities of the M.A.S. organization. Members placed ads honoring milestones in the lives of members and honoring deceased family members, most likely living in the early 1900s. The ads, in many cases, consisted of photographs of the deceased loved ones.
