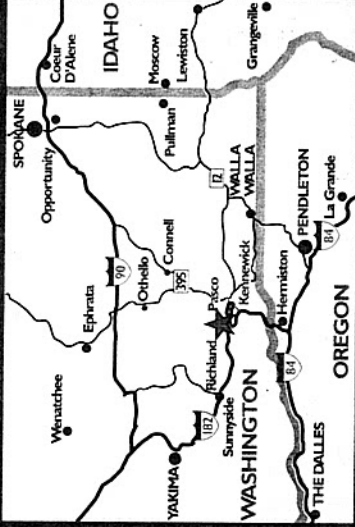

The CARF accredited Inpatient Rehabilitation Center at Kadlec Medical Center is a medically supervised comprehensive program. Our professional staff evaluates, treats, trains and educates adults with disabilities to reintegrate them back into the community. The 12 bed unit includes 2 dialysis rooms, a patient kitchen and laundry facilities. An open multi-purpose room provides patients and their families opportunities to regularly interact with the staff and other patients.

Staff and Services

Our highly specialized staff of psychiatrists, nurses, and therapists work with the patient and their family to develop a treatment plan that will help the patient gain optimal function independence before returning to the community.

Our nursing staff, including certified rehabilitation and certified orthopedic nurses, who work with the patients and family members with day-to-day care. They help educate individuals in the care needed for when the loved one returns home.

In addition to the nursing staff, patients will work with other skilled professionals, including, but not limited to, physical and occupational therapists, speech pathologists, respiratory therapists, registered dietitians, and social workers. They also have the opportunity to be involved with the massage therapists and the recreational therapist.

Appropriate diagnoses for admission include, but are not limited to:

- Stroke
- Brain Injury
- Neurological Conditions
- Spinal Cord Dysfunction
- Amputation
- Fractures
- Major Trauma
- Functional Debility
- Orthopedic Injuries

Who will benefit from admission to an acute rehabilitation center?

People with functional impairments resulting from trauma, illness, or complex surgery.

People who show evidence of being able to participate in three hours or more of rehabilitative therapy activities a day.

People whose medical condition is stable enough to allow participation in rehabilitation activities.

People who require the intervention of more than one therapy specialty.

People who are likely to make functional gains as a result of an inpatient rehabilitation stay and return to their community.

What is CARF accreditation?

CARF is an independent, not-for-profit accrediting body promoting quality, value and optimal outcomes of services. An organization receiving the coveted 3-year accreditation voluntarily undergoes a rigorous peer review process and demonstrates that its programs and services are of the highest quality.
