

**Midterm Exam Results
Philosophy 120A
Autumn, 2007**

The results of the midterm exam are as follows. There were 102 points possible (34 questions at 3 points each). Scores ranged from a high of 99 to a low of 15. The average score was 61.47, and the median score was 63. The standard deviation was 17.17 points.

The distribution of scores, by decile, is listed in the chart below. The grade point listed is a **projection**, not an assigned grade. It is based on pegging the median score of 63 to a projected grade of not less than 2.8. This projection does not take into account scores on homework or the final exam, which will obviously have a great impact on the final grade. In a recent quarter, for example, one student with a 60 on the midterm ended up with a 3.7 in the course; another with a 63 ended up with a 0.7. So please use these projections cautiously.
